Californians and Their Government March 2021 Time Trends – All Respondents

Methodology Note:

Findings for March 2021 are based on a survey of 1,706 California adult residents, with 75 percent interviewed on cell phones (1,269 interviews) and 25 percent interviewed on landline telephones (437 interviews). Live landline and cell phone interviews were conducted in English and Spanish according to the respondents' preferences. Interviews took an average of 19 minutes to complete. Interviewing took place on weekend days and weekday nights March 14-23, 2021.

The sampling error for March 2021, taking design effects from weighting into consideration, is ±3.3 percent at the 95 percent confidence level for the total unweighted sample of 1,706 adults. This means that 95 times out of 100, the results will be within 3.3 percentage points of what they would be if all adults in California were interviewed. Sampling error is only one type of error to which surveys are subject. Results may also be affected by factors such as question wording, question order, and survey timing.
